Motion and fire detectors let you know when areas have been breached or a fire is detected. Once detected an alarm will be sounded and authorities notified.



Dallastown School District

Dallastown, Pennsylvania



End User:

Dallastown Area School District serves nearly 6,000 students in five kindergarten through fifth grade elementary schools, a sixth grade to eighth grade middle school, and a grade nine through grade twelve high school. The district employs 417 instructional staff, 277 support staff and 30 administrators.

Business Objective:

The school district's IT department sought a flexible IP video surveillance system that would allow administrative staff and the school's resource officer to easily search and playback recorded video to determine the events surrounding incidents at the schools. Secretaries also needed to view video of the entrances from their desks, in order to see a person requesting access to the school before unlocking the doors.

Solution:

- FlexiDome and AutoDome Modular Day/Night IP cameras
- Video storage = RAID arrays with Bosch Video Recording Manager (creates a virtual pool of storage and allocates disk space where needed)

 BVMS Video Management Software Suite (search and playback video)

Result:

The school district reports that the system helps administrators more quickly identify which students were involved in incidents that happen in the schools. The students are more likely to be truthful about the role they played, when they see themselves on recorded video, and the SRO can more easily prove that bullying took place, and discipline offenders, when images of taunting and shoving are captured.

The district is also intending to install cameras on the perimeter of the school's campus. With wireless access points on a rooftop or light pole, Dallastown can extend campus surveillance to more remote areas, and allow police to review video inside the school and assess the situation before entering, if a serious security incident were to occur.

Bosch was recently awarded a contract from the Virginia Beach School District for an all encompassing security and sound system solution. In just one month, the district has already realized a 98% reduction in false alarms after the installation of Bosch motion detectors.



- 1. Establish a Security & Safety team with a mix of dedicated participants e.g., maintenance, teacher, office personnel, local police.
- 2. Build a security and safety plan: identify short-term and long-term requirements, brainstorm ideas to eliminate risks. Roll outcome into a risk assessment.
- 3. Investigate funding resources: check with your district first. State, local and federal grants require an application and usually require submittal of a complete and thorough risk assessment.
- 4. Integrate administrators, teachers, parents, students, and local police into your process. Share planning and clearly communicate roles. Engage local authorities to participate in town meetings/assemblies.
- 5. Initiate practice drills into your routine to ensure all parties execute roles properly.
- 6. Schedule yearly evaluations to check process and identify changes.
